



CULVERT REPLACEMENT CONSTRUCTION
BENDER ROAD CLOSURE

September 4, 2018

Dear Resident:

We are sending this letter to you on behalf of the Town of Lebanon. The Town is planning to replace four metal culverts in Town which are in disrepair. Anchor Engineering has completed the design for the replacements and the culverts are located on **Bender Road**, Card Street, Church Road and Olenick Road.

Construction will be starting on **Bender Road** on September 10th. The existing metal culvert on **Bender Road** carries Susquetonscut Brook and is located between **167 and 219 Bender Road**. Milton C. Beebe & Sons, Inc. will be the Contractor completing the work. A new steel reinforced polyethylene pipe with metal pipe ends will be installed to replace the deteriorated metal pipe. A portion of the roadway will be reconstructed on each approach to the culvert and guide railing installed.

To allow the work to be completed in the shortest amount of time, **Bender Road** will be closed in the area of the existing culvert starting on **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 14th** and is expected to be closed until the end of October. Construction and detour signs will be installed. Emergency and Board of Education personnel are aware of the work and will be updated as construction moves forward. The Town is looking forward to completing these improvements and thanks you for your patience during this temporary travelling inconvenience.
