Lebanon's Farmers' Market begins its third season on Saturday June 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. at Lebanon Town Hall, 579 Exeter Road and runs through October. During July and August the Market will also now be open Wednesday afternoons from 3:30 – 6:00 p.m. Now residents and visitors alike will be able to supply their table and stock their shelves with locally grown and made foods twice weekly!

Come sample the finest local vegetables, meats, fruits, cheese, eggs, herbs, baked goods, honey, wool products, soaps, bath & body products, flora and fauna, and more! Come learn from a Master Gardener! Come hear live music provided by Jim Ferguson that will lift your spirits! Come see the walking talking vegetables!

On opening day June 6<sup>th</sup> the first 150 customers will receive a free "Lebanon Farmers' Market" reusable grocery bag with a minimum \$5.00 purchase (one per customer).
