

# **AN ORDINANCE CREATING A MUNICIPAL FLOOD AND EROSION CONTROL BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF LEBANON**

BE IT ORDAINED by the electors of the Town of Lebanon at a duly warned Special Town Meeting held July 30, 1984:

1. The Town of Lebanon, acting herein by its legislative body, does hereby adopt the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes, Sections 25-84 to 25-94, inclusive, and hereby establishes the Town of Lebanon Municipal Flood and Erosion Control Board which shall exercise such powers as are granted to it by the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Said Board shall consist of not less than five regular members and three alternate members, all of whom shall be registered voters of the Town of Lebanon. Said members shall be appointed by the Selectmen for three year terms, provided, however, that the original Board shall consist of two members appointed for three year terms, two members appointed for two year terms and one member appointed for a one year term.
3. Of the five regular members appointed by the Selectmen, one member shall be from the Red Cedar Lake area, one member shall be from the Amston Lake Tax District, and one member shall be from the Lake Williams Beach Association; provided, however, that in the event that the Selectmen are unable to locate a qualified person from any of said areas, then the Selectmen shall appoint any registered voter of the Town of Lebanon to fill the position.

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in accordance with the General Statutes.
