I. IW-BUF-19-8027: Chad and Ursula Nehrt (owners), Brett Harlow (applicant), 72 Deepwood Drive, Assessors Map 103, Lot 84. Landscaping and concrete patio removal. Discuss and act.

Brett Harlow was present. The Commission walked the site and inquired if wetlands had been flagged and if the property was located in the Flood Zone. Mr. Harlow stated that the property was flagged in 2012 and that he was unsure if it was located in the Flood Zone.

Mr. Chester will investigate the Flood Zone. This application will be discussed at the August 5, 2019 Commission meeting.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting to 116 Deepwood Drive.

II. IW-BUF-19-7814: Patrice Kaneda, 116 Deepwood Drive, Assessors Map 103, Lot 75. New single-family dwelling. Discuss and act.

Patrice Kaneda was present. The Commission walked the site and reviewed the site plan. Discussion ensued about adding addition E&S controls and determining the amount of soil to be stockpiled and removed from the site.

Mr. Chester recommended that the applicant have their contractor and/or surveyor at the August 5, 2019 Commission meeting where this item will next be discussed.
