Jonathan Trumbull Library January 16th, 2020 Regular Meeting – Board of Trustees Lebanon Town Hall

Present: Cathe McCall, Maureen McCall, Janice Knudsen, Colleen Meese, Bill Goba, Berkeley Nowosad and Library Directors Matt Earls and Frances McGrath

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by the chairman, Cathe McCall.

Minutes to the December 5th special meeting – Motion (Janice Knudsen/Colleen Meese) to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed with one abstention.

Correspondence – Letter from ACLB and Diane McCall's resignation from the board. Matt passed around several newspaper articles on the library activities and about Frances.

Frances McGrath was introduced to the entire board.

Director's Report – Matt reported.

- 2019-2020 Budget numbers distributed. We have spent about 88% of the sixmonth allocation for the first half of the fiscal year. Several of the line items were moved to different 'buckets' and some numbers might appear to be skewed. The market is doing well so our invested funds are doing well.

- Program Highlights December total for attendees at children's programs was 280 (218 in December 2018) and adult programs for December is 85, down from 109 in 2018.
- Personnel Frances has moved up to Linda's position and Matt is interviewing for a program coordinator for the adult programs. Fran is in grad school working on her MLS. The programs are ready for January because Fran worked on them during the holiday break but with school back in session, it is important to fill that position.
