Jonathan Trumbull Library February 20th, 2020 Regular Meeting – Board of Trustees Lebanon Town Hall

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by the chairman, Cathe McCall.

Minutes to the January 16th regular meeting – Motion (Janice Knudsen/Michelle Kersey) to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed with two abstentions.

Director's Report – Matt reported.

- Personnel Matt had broached the subject of hiring a Program Coordinator with the selectmen but they suggested that he hire a contractor instead. Motion (Berkley Nowosad/Michelle Kersey) to approve that Matt contract for services of an independent contractor for program coordination. The motion carried unanimously. Kathleen Plante has been a Library Aide for 14 years and would like to be promoted to Senior Library Aide. Motion (Eilleen Weinsteiger/Colleen Meese) that Kathleen Plante be moved to Senior Library Aide with an increase in salary accordingly. The motion carried unanimously.

- Facilities Furnace in the nonfiction room is no longer working and the room is now heated with electric and tea is available both upstairs and downstairs.
- Circulation is still looking good.
