

Lebanon Town Pool Rules 2019

In accordance with the State of Connecticut

Law 19-13-B33 (b) (17) must be followed:

1. All persons shall bathe with warm water and soap before entering the pool.
2. Any persons known or suspected of having a Communicable Disease shall not use the pool.
3. Spitting or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
4. Running, boisterous or rough play (Except supervised water sports) is prohibited.

Other rules that need to be followed

5. Pool will be closed by lifeguards due to weather conditions or an incident.
6. All swimmers will be tested by the lifeguards and will be permitted into the deep area according to skill
7. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult
8. Flotation devices will be provided by staff and no other flotation devices will be permitted, no flotation in deep end of the pool, an adult must supervise a child wearing a flotation device that do not swim, Infants must wear swim diapers
9. Long hair must be tied back
10. No diving allowed anywhere in the pool
11. No glass products or food in pool area
12. No sitting or standing on the stairs

In the event that any of these regulations are not followed, the lifeguards at the Lebanon Town Pool reserve the authority to refuse admittance or ask anyone to leave for any reason if it is in the best interest of the facility and the safety of our patrons.
